## Recycling Guidelines

*Must be a NTSWA refuse customer to have your recycling picked up by NTSWA*

**Aluminum Cans:** Please empty & rinse cans. Crushing is optional but saves space.

**Corrugated Cardboard:** Flatten boxes & keep dry. Look for the ridges. No cereal/macaroni boxes, etc.

**Glass Bottles & Jars:** Separate bottles & jars by color; clear, brown, green. Remove all lids & rings. Rinse well, labels can remain.

**Magazines:** Magazines & catalogs only. Keep dry. Do not bundle or tie. Keep separate from other types of paper.

**Newspapers:** Keep dry. Inserts can remain. Do not bundle or tie. Keep separate from other types of paper.

**Office Paper/Junk Mail:** Includes junk mail, office paper, envelopes, colored paper, shredded paper, etc.

Keep dry. Do not bundle or tie. Keep separate from other types of paper.

**Plastic Bottles & Containers:** Includes soda & water bottles, milk & laundry jugs, shampoo bottles, yogurt containers, butter tubs, berry containers, etc...Empty & rinse as necessary. Lids can remain. Crushing is optional but saves space.

**NO HARD OR BULKY PLASTICS, NO BLACK PLASTIC, NO PLASTIC BAGS, NO STYROFOAM, NO OIL CONTAINERS, NO FLOWER POTS**

**Steel or "Tin" Cans:** Rinse your cans & secure the lid(s) inside. Labels can remain.

### Special Collections:



**Spring Cleanup:** May 1, 2021



**Fall Cleanup:** September 18, 2021

Includes appliances, furniture, garage/attic waste. No C/D waste or hazardous waste

**Tire Collection:** Deliver behind the Borough Building on September 18, 2021; limit 10 per person



**Brush/Leaf/Tree Collection:** These will be collected on November 10, 2021 (subject to change; weather pending)

**Christmas Tree Collection:** Collected on normal refuse days in January 2021

### Refuse Collection Schedule:

Refuse will be collected from all households and select businesses on Mondays and all business establishments on Thursdays, except holidays. **PLACE CURBSIDE BY 7AM**

### Collection Parcels

Elkland Borough requires that occupants of all residences and businesses place all waste in plastic bags or approved containers not weighing in excess of 35 pounds. Any garbage that cannot be placed in bags must be in boxes or bundles that are securely bound and do not exceed 4 feet in length or 2 feet wide. NTSWA will collect 3 bags or parcels from each resident. Bags or parcels over this limit need to be tagged with a NTSWA refuse sticker.
